



#### Fraud Prevention - How to keep your Card Number Safe

These following tips can help PREVENT and STOP fraud on your card:

- Always monitor your account. If you see any questionable account activity, please notify us as soon as possible to prevent further loss.
- Keep your card in a secure location at all times. Try to keep your card in the same location, so that it does not get lost or easily stolen by a criminal.
- 3. If you do lose your card, please notify us immediately. If your lost card is returned back to you, it could be compromised. The BEST course of action is to contact us to cancel the card and issue you a new card with a new card number. If your card is lost/stolen after hours, please call 855.490.2380 for debit and 855.519.9869 for credit.
- 4. When using your card number online, make sure that you have reliable and updated virus software protection on your computers and verify that any site you are on is secure.
- 5. If someone calls you saying that you owe them money, it is very likely that it could be a scam. Look up the correct phone number of who they say they are representing and call that place of business to see if they contacted you. It's better to be safe and know who you are speaking with.

Supervisory Committee: Charlie Campbell


Additional Nominations will not be accepted from the floor. The following procedure must be followed to enter a name on the ballot:

- Pick up an application from the credit union during business hours.
- Obtain signatures from 80 valid members in good standing with the Credit Union.
- 3. Complete a biographical data form and pass a background check, bonding review and credit check.
- Return the application, signatures and biographical data form to either the Credit Union office or the Board Secretary, Owen Rexroat, no later than 11:00 AM, Thursday, February 16, 2016.

If there are additional nominations approved, the final ballot will be posted at the credit union offices no later than 11:00 AM, Thursday, March 17, 2016. For joint membership, there will still be only one vote per member - and only one of the joint members can vote for that account in an election. To be eligible to vote, the membership account must have a minimum balance of \$5.00. No member may personally have more than one vote in an election. Organizational accounts are allowed one vote. There will be no off-site ballot boxes. You must be present to vote.
