Example: John Doe (your signature)[payee signature(s)] For Mobile Deposit Only Harvester Financial CU

- 3. Snap the pictures of your check.
- 4. Click Submit.

Recent government regulations have made it necessary to endorse the back of the check with "For mobile deposit only" in addition to your signature.
